

The Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program 2025-26 School Year

General Information

Diocesan Tuition Assistance is awarded each year to families with children in our Catholic schools in grades K-8. Awards are made based on financial need. Families who apply can receive up to one-half of the school's in-parish tuition rate.

How is the determination made? Information contained in the application along with the supporting materials is used to determine financial need. The formula utilized has been especially designed for families with children attending Catholic school. FACTS includes a comprehensive review and verification process ensuring the accuracy of the data.

How to apply (One application per family) Applications will be available online November 1, 2024, at <https://online.factsmgt.com>. Online applications are available in English and Spanish.

- The application fee is \$35, and it is due at the time the application is submitted. The application fee of \$35 will be added to your tuition assistance award if you receive a Diocesan tuition assistance award.
- Allow approximately two weeks for FACTS to process each document once it is uploaded. If additional documents are needed, an email will be sent from FACTS. All "Complete" applications by the due dates will be considered for The Diocesan Tuition Assistance Program.

Grades K-8

- **Applications completed by March 1, 2025**, will be evaluated in Round 1. **2023 Federal tax forms are required.** Email award notifications will be sent to all families with a "COMPLETE" application on April 10th. You need to "Accept" the award and register with the school or decline by May 10th.
- **Applications completed by May 12, 2025**, will be evaluated in Round 2. **2024 Federal tax forms are required.** Email award notifications will be sent to all families with a "COMPLETE" application on June 11th. You need to "Accept" the award and register with the school or decline by July 15th.

Grades 9-12

- Awards are based on a rolling submission. Notification will be made by the high school. Visit your high school's website for more information.
